Senator Lena Gonzalez represents nearly 1 million residents of Los Angeles County in the State's 33rd District. The 33rd District drives California and our Nation's economy, from the Port of Long Beach to the transportation corridor that links California to the rest of the country.

Recently Senator Gonzalez was appointed Chair of the State's Senate Transportation Committee, becoming the first Latina in over 50 years to be assigned to this role. This powerful Committee has jurisdiction over California High-Speed Rail Authority, California Highway Patrol, California Transportation Commission, Department of Motor Vehicles, Department of Transportation (Caltrans), driver's licenses, freight, regional transportation agencies, transit authorities, intercity rail, mobile sources of air pollution, fuels, rules of the road, state highways, and local streets.

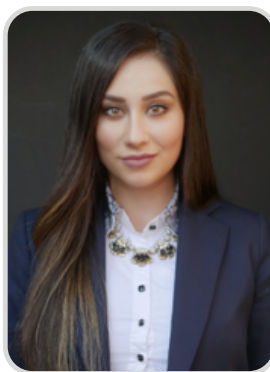
